All members with a Visa card starting with the numbers 4721 will be getting a new card. This reissue is being completed to allow us to consolidate and streamline our processes and to help us reduce costs.

Your benefits will not change in any way! Your rate will not change in any way!

We will be mailing an informational letter on February 3, 2021. This will just be a reminder notice to let you know the card is coming and of the important dates.

You will receive your card in the mail prior to February 22, 2021. DO NOT ACTIVATE your card or try to use it before February 22, 2021. It will not work. The card is being mailed before the consolidation date so you have the card in hand on the activation date of February 22, 2021. On February 22, 2021 you will need to call and activate your new card and destroy the card beginning with 4721. This card will no longer work as of February 22, 2021.
