- Our SECU mobile app is a great place to start! Just open the app and in the upper right hand corner you will find "ATM Locator".
- Another option is to open the Shazam Bolts app. Sign into the app and you will be able to locate THOUSANDS of ATMs with Privileged Status. All of these are fee free as well!
- Your card is also good at any MoneyPass ATM nationwide. Currently there are 32,000 fee free ATMs available, including 8,000 locations in 7-Eleven stores coast to coast!
- And finally you can go to www.moneypass.com/atmlocator.html or shazam.net to find Privileged Status ATMs.
